YOUTH SERVICES



We believe when young people are given high quality support and knowledge, they are empowered to make positive changes and build a positive future.

YOUTH & FAMILY SUPPORT

We provide support to young people and their families to build strong relationships. Reconnect supports youth who are having issues at home and/or school to connect with family, education, employment and their community through case management, counselling, parenting groups & youth groups.

EDUCATION

Young people who need support with education or are disconnected from school, are supported to improve their situation. We also provide life skills education & one-to-one support.

ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUGS

We assist young people & their families who want support about alcohol & other drugs through the READY service. We provide practical and emotional support (case management & counselling) and also deliver a range of educational and prevention workshops and programs.

MENTAL HEALTH & WELL-BEING

Young people are provided with tools to overcome mental health challenges. We provide one-to-one and group workshops through School Well-Being projects. We also facilitate education and awareness on health and well-being matters.

EMPLOYMENT

Young people are supported to meet employment goals. Transition To Work provides intensive support for young people to obtain employment, apprenticeships, traineeships, work experience or education.

YOUTH HOMELESSNESS

We support young people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless to stabilise their living situation.

DIVERSITY

Diversity should be celebrated - we are helping youth do so through one-to-one support, small group workshops as well as larger scale awareness activities for a range of diverse needs.

COMMUNITY SERVICES



We believe in building stronger communities through high quality services, one that empowers people to make positive changes and build a positive future.

PREVENTING HOMELESSNESS

Helping Hand is our long established service which specialises in the prevention of homelessness for people 16 years and over who are at-risk, or are already homeless.
